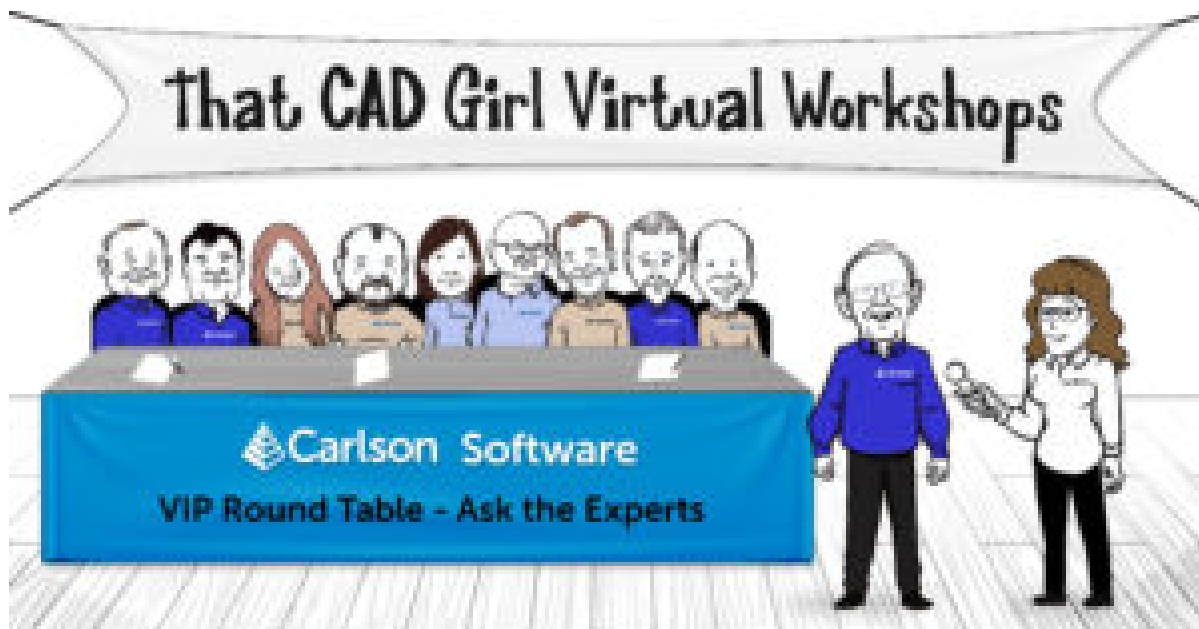

Virtual Workshops 2022 – a line-up that goes and goes and goes...!

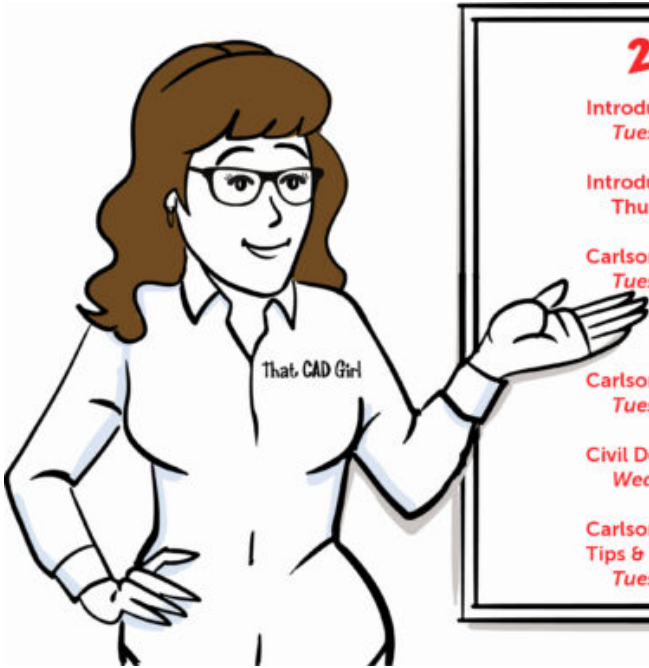

It's a little late but [Carlson Software](#) made a “soft release” of the [2022 version of their desktop products](#) earlier this morning – Thursday 12/30/2021. A “soft release” is basically a release without the balloons and streamers!

The Carlson products released today include an embedded copy of IntelliCAD 10.0a and 10.1a and can also run on top of your separately purchased license of AutoCAD 2017-2022. Carlson Survey and Takeoff 2022 with embedded AutoCAD (OEM) are expected to be released within the next few weeks and an update will be posted at the top of this blog post.
